



COVID-19 Return to Play- Recreation Facilities

Municipality of Ritchot Facilities are committed to ensuring the health and safety of our user groups and staff. Facilities may be limited to participants of pre-arranged bookings and appointments. Spectators will be limited as per the public health order.

General guidelines for all facility users

- Self-screening for coaches, instructors and participants must occur before entry into the facility. Please use the provincial screening tool available at <https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/>.
- Please stay home if you are experiencing any symptoms, even if they are mild.
- There will be COVID-19 related signage throughout the facility reminding patrons of physical distancing guidelines, hand hygiene and cough etiquette.
- Masks are mandatory in the building at all times except for when actively engaged in athletic or fitness activities.
- Follow guidelines from provincial and national sport organizations and facility site plans to minimize physical contact and risk of COVID-19 transmission between participants.
- The renter is responsible for the actions of their group or members.
- Renters are strongly encouraged to keep a list of the members of their group and contact information for 21 days to ensure appropriate public health follow-up can take place if a participant is exposed to COVID-19.
- Children under the age of 12yrs must be accompanied by an adult, this can be a parent/guardian or designated adult.
- Participants are strongly encouraged to maintain physical distancing of 2 metres (6ft) as much as possible within the facility including in dressing rooms and washrooms.
- Spectators are limited to 50% occupancy, please be mindful of posted spectator maximums.

Building entry

- In accordance with public health restrictions, upon entering the facility all persons over the age of 18yrs must:
 - Produce proof that they are fully immunized along with government issued ID
 - Produce proof from the Government of Manitoba that there is a medical reason for the person not to receive a vaccine for COVID-19
- Arena staff will verify vaccination status using the Manitoba Immunization Verifier Application.

- Entrance will be through the marked doors at the main entrance.
- Upon arrival, every individual entering the building is to use the hand sanitizer located in the main lobby.
- Participants will be able to enter the facility 15 minutes prior to their rental time.
- Participants are strongly encouraged to come fully dressed- minus helmets and skates.

Leaving the building

- Participants must exit the building within 15 minutes after their session. All users are to remove skates and equipment and leave the facility as quickly as possible so that the areas can be cleaned and sanitized.
