Shane,

With the release of the [latest public health orders](#), we want to clarify that the gathering limits outlined in orders 1-3 **do not** supersede the spectator gathering limits in the sport-related orders 14, 15 and 17.

Outdoor

The number of spectators at an outdoor sporting or recreational facility must not exceed 50% of the usual spectator capacity of the facility.

Indoor

As proof of vaccination is required for indoor sport facilities, no spectator capacity restrictions apply.

In addition, now that the province has moved to the restricted (orange) level on the [pandemic response system](#), there are no specific changes related to sport.

We are also awaiting information regarding requiring proof of vaccination for sport participants aged 12-17, and we will update you should we receive further clarifications.
